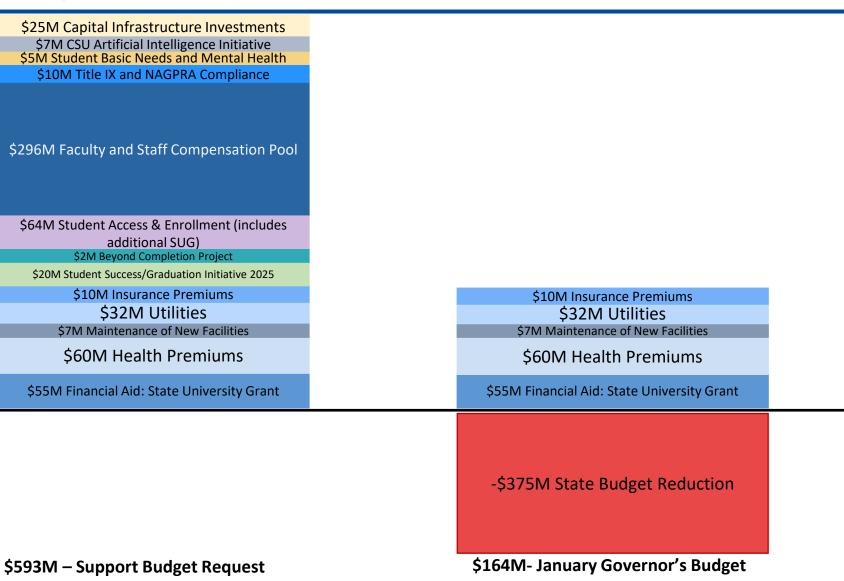

### 2025-2026 State & CSU Budget Planning



## The Governor's January Budget Proposal includes a \$375M reduction to the CSU. CSU is funding mandatory costs with the 6% tuition increase.



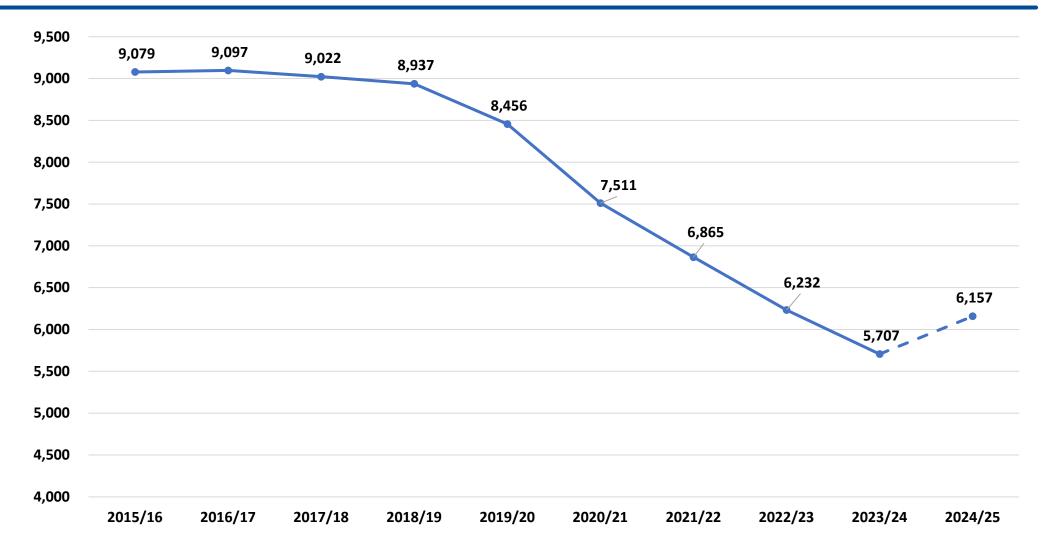


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### **Historical Base Reductions**

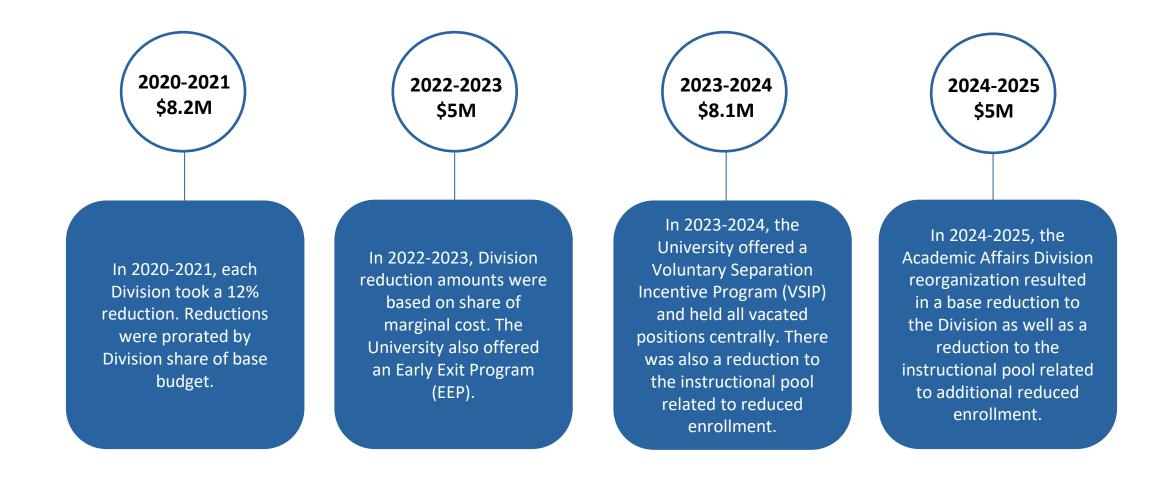


College year (CY) headcount has declined approximately 32% since the highest year of 2016/17 and was at the lowest point in 2023/24.



\*The 2024-2025 year headcount figure is not final for the year as we are confirming Spring census figures

The University has used different methodologies to take an accumulated \$26.3M in base reductions over the past five years, with no base reduction taken in 2021-2022.



# The \$26.3M in reductions from 2020-2021 to 2024-2025 have largely impacted position lines and the instructional pool.

-UBAC provides recommendation to the President

#### July

-2025/2026 budget finalized
